Tuition Deposit \$500.00- Due at time of enrollment. No child is officially enrolled until this advance tuition payment is received. It is an initial tuition payment but is non-refundable.

Multi-child discount- In a multiple child family, the oldest child will pay 100% of tuition. All subsequent children in the same family receive the multi-child discount shown above. Deposits are not discounted.

Need Based Financial Aid is available and applications are made through a third party program (FACTS), which can be accessed during the online application/enrollment process. Families receiving scholarships from other organizations will be assessed for eligibility based on financial need. **Financial Aid does not apply to Preschool or K-prep.**

Emmanuel church discount- Members will receive a 5% tuition discount.

Supplies- School supplies and classroom materials are included in tuition.
